# Access to capital market financing for Czech Small and Medium-Sized Enterprises

SMEs in the Czech Republic have a comparatively low knowledge of capital market instruments and opt for using predominantly their own resources or bank financing. Therefore, in cooperation with the Directorate General for Structural Reform Support (DG REFORM) of the European Commission, the Ministry of Finance has prepared a **project to present the capital market to Czech entrepreneurs** as a possible alternative for financing their businesses via the educational website kapitalovypruvodce.cz (Capital Guide).

### **About the Capital Guide**

Capital Guide is a website with the main purpose of acquainting small and medium-sized enterprises with **alternatives to traditional bank financing**. The Capital Guide website will direct SMEs towards these alternative methods of business financing and the experts who can guide them in choosing a suitable financial instrument and support them with securing the financing.

### **Project objectives**

The main goal of the project is to **increase awareness** about the Czech capital market and the opportunities which it provides to small and mediumsized enterprises. The second objective is to **improve the functioning and resilience of the Czech economy** by diversifying the source of finance.

### **Guiding SMEs**

- The project was introduced to the public via an online conference including workshops on the 29<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
- The Capital Guide contains a wide range of information about the capital market and covers the main issues and questions entrepreneurs may have about fundraising.
- On the website, entrepreneurs will find a useful quiz which serves as an initial guide to the right financial instrument.
- With the help of a step by step guide, entrepreneurs will have the opportunity to become acquainted with the capital market various financial instruments and to choose an expert who will guide them through the process of fundraising.


- How does the financial instrument work?

### Video content


The video content aims to attract visitors to the website, guide its users, educate entrepreneurs and inspire them to successfully finance their businesses on the capital market.


