### 1. The challenges of evidence, policy coherence and policy coordination

#### WICKED PROBLEMS

Multidimensional / do not have a definitive formulation

Lack a "stopping rule": managed more than solved

Solutions are not "true" or "false", nor can they be *tested*: some solutions will work better on multiple dimensions (or not)



#### 1. The challenges of evidence, policy coherence and policy coordination

Achieving policy coherence and policy coordination to properly address multidimensionality

Constant supply of up-to-date, reliable, evidence on what works and how people feel about it

to properly adjust strategies to "moving targets"

#### 2. The role of boundary organizations


Support transdiciplinary and multidisciplinary research;

"Safe spaces" for different actors to meet and discuss ideas, develop closer relationships, improving trust

Play an important role in managing tensions across borders

Produce outputs recognized as credible by all involved;

BOs play a crucial role in harnessing evidence

#### 2. The role of boundary organizations

What is "evidence"?

Information that improves policy quality and decision-making:

Scientific data;

Data on citizen perceptions about a


given issue;

Protocols (e.g. for evaluation);

Indicators (e.g. for monitoring);

...

**BOs have a knowledge brokerage function** - adjust evidence supply to demand and may (should) antecipate demand




