


# STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK

The Italian reform priorities in public administration are set in the agenda approved in as part of the National Resilience and Recovery Programme (NRRP). The reform focuses on human capital and public employment, digitalisation, and administrative simplification. Local governments responsible for implementing reform are provided with technical and planning assistance through a project involving the 'Deposits and loans fund' and the National Agency for Inward Investment and Economic Development (Invitalia). 


Employment by government level




Average population per local government 7,434


