# Sharing information on multi-country requests

Objective: *identify common needs and facilitate multi-country requests*


## 1. DG REFORM

- Create **platform** for information sharing
- European Commission ideas for **multi-country projects** (on voluntary basis)

## 2. Coordinating Authorities:

- Populate platform with multi-country **request ideas** (informal, no commitment)
