## Multi-country (multi-region) projects

A multi-country or multi-region project is a technical support project that is relevant or common to more than one Member State as it belongs to the same policy area and addresses the same priorities for technical support



# 2 types of multi-country requests

Coordinated submission of same/similar requests by different Member States

#### Examples from TSI 2022:

- Micro-data platform
  (DE, FR, LV, PT, SK, SI)
- Hub for Sustainable Investments in Health (AT, BE, SI)

Request submission by one Member State on behalf of other Member States

#### Examples from TSI 2022:

- Evidence-informed policymaking in governance & public administration (BE, CZ, EE, EL, FI, LT, LV, NL)
- Anti-money laundering risk analysis and supervision

(BE, CZ, DE, ES, FR, LV, NL)
